Back in December, I volunteered at Seneca Slopes. I offered to be the course sweeper, which was a ton of fun and easy. Even better, I didn't have to get up early for my volunteer job that started later during this 9am race. After the race started, I jogged the entire course and pulled down the plastic plate course markings that had been set up. I also helped the course marshals stack cones. Sweeping was really fun and allowed me to enjoy the entire course at my own pace and with some built in stops along the way. I got some additional miles in beforehand and made a nice long run out of it. Seneca Slopes has a beautiful race course and as a walk or jog in the woods sweeping is a great volunteer job! Thank you Michele and Chuck Potter for putting on a fantastic race! Maybe we can swap out the rain for snow next year.

A few weeks ago I volunteered at the club's last race in 2023, Jingle Bell Jog. It



seemed fitting to volunteer to clean up the course.
